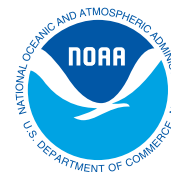

The Alaska Sea Grant State Fellowship Program strengthens the workforce dedicated to healthy fisheries, coastal environments, and watersheds by encouraging graduate students to launch careers in Alaska.

The state fellowship program provides a unique professional opportunity for graduate students interested in Alaska's marine, coastal, and watershed resources and policy decision-making. The 12-month paid fellowship offers on-the-job experience to highly motivated students who are matched with Alaska-based state, federal and tribal agencies and nonprofits. Graduate students close to completing a degree, or with a recently earned degree, are eligible. The deadline to apply for this fellowship is in February.
